

# HISTORY

## Journey that started 7 years back

We had observed the number of Co-Operative apartment as well as individual buildings unable to start / left incomplete due to lack of basic infrastructure accompanied by foul play of unscrupulous contractors. This induced us into forming the Welfare Association in the name of **NEW TOWN 1B BLOCK WELFARE ASSOCIATION, Reg No SIL/70803 dated 07.05.2010 Under West Bengal Society Regulation Act** with the Vision to co-ordinate with WBHIDCO/ NKDA time to time and to resolve the various issues of the Residents also to make social bonding among all residents of Action Area 1B.

In simultanaeity, we also started cultural wing under our Association to promote the local talent and togetherness. It is noteworthy that Action Area 1, has been divided in four parts like AA-1A, AA -1B, AA -1C and AA-1D. We, AA-1B residents started Celebration "**SARBOJANIN DURGA PUJA**" since 2010, 1st time in the Satellite City in India. Since then every year we have been celebrating Bengal's greatest festival as well as Kalipuja, Lakshmi Puja, Dolyatra, Bijaya Sammilani , Rabindra-Nazrul Sandhya and day by day our social bounding increased through various cultural & Social activities.

We have also secured significant awards and accolades in connection with prizes of Puja as organized by NKDA. From the inception of this 1B welfare association, we are coordinating with WBHIDCO/ NKDA Management in all aspects, so that the infrastructure development of Action Area 1B could take place at the earliest and Basic Civic Amenities could be made available to the residents and plot holders, without which it would be difficult for one to settle in NEW TOWN. We are maintaining contact and communication with different statutory authorities like WBHIDCO and NKDA periodically. We are also happy to note that the authorities are also taking keen interest and co-operating with us for doing the needful as per as possible. Happiest outcome so far is obtaining the plot of land from HIDCO/NKDA in favour of 1B Welfare Association for community purposes.
